


MIXING & FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Mix 1.5 lb (3 measures)* of powder with 7 pints of water (to make 1 gallon of milk replacer). Add powder to 1/3 of the quantity of required water (warm to 120° F. or cold). Fill up to the required volume with cold water. Mix fresh each day. Always feed to baby pigs at room temperature.

Ad Libitum Feeding

(As a Supplement for Orphan and Surplus Pigs)

Be sure liquid diet is available at all times from a suitable feeder.

MANAGEMENT

- Reconstituted acidified formula stays fresh up to 24 hours because of acids and preservatives.
- Adjust quantities according to appetite.
- Avoid overfeeding to reduce risk of scours.
- Wean pigs at 10-12 lb of body weight.
- Ensure adequate trough space for all pigs in group.
- For orphan and surplus pigs, raise in groups of 8-10 pigs for best results.
- Hygiene is important. Keep feeding equipment clean.

If smaller quantities are required, adjust feeding amount accordingly.

* 1 level measuring cup (enclosed in bag) equals 1/2 lb of dry powder. Check cup quantity periodically.
