Contains a source of alpha-galactosidase suitable for use in poultry and swine feed which can hydrolyze oligosaccharides.

GUARANTEED ANALYSIS:

Alpha-galactosidase (*S. cerevisiae*): minimum 8 units/g (3,600 units/Lb.) where 8 units of alpha-galactosidase converts 100 micromole/minute of p-nitrophenyl-alpha-D-galactopyranoside (PNPG) to galactose and p-nitrophenol at pH 5.0 / 37 C.

Xylanase (*T. longibrachiatum*): minimum 300 units/g (136,000 units/Lb.) where 300 units produces 300 micromole of reducing sugar (as xylose) at pH 5.0 and 50 C.

INGREDIENTS: Rice Hulls, Calcium Carbonate, Processed Grain By-Products, Dried *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* Fermentation Extract, Dried *Aspergillus niger* Fermentation Extract, Dried *Trichoderma longibrachiatum* Fermentation Extract.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use 1/3 - 1/2 Lb. per ton (150-250 grams per 1000 Kgs) of feed.
