FIRST AID

This product shall not be used to formulate or repackage a registered product in paints, stains, coatings, inks and dyes intended for use in arts, crafts or finger paints. Nor shall it be used to formulate or repackage a registered product for use in any broadcast carpet, rug or upholstery application.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Apply dust uniformly to floor of poultry house/hog barns/barns to old litter with appropriate equipment such as a drop spreader, fertilizer or seed spreader at 2 pounds per 100 square feet of applied area.
- 2) Boric acid may be applied to all litter or in bands underneath feed lines and against side walls.
- 3) Wear a dust mask or a respirator while applying.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a dry place. Do not store where children or animals may gain access.
