

DISH DETERGENT

GENERAL PURPOSE DISH WASHING COMPOUND

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use 1/2 ounce per gallon of hot water for normal dish washing and increase to 1 ounce per gallon of hot water for oily food residues. For maximum foam, place detergent in sink first and then add water at maximum pressure. To remove baked-on or burned food from utensils, soak in a solution of about 2 ounces per gallon of hot water. Soak or wash dishes clean, rinse in hot water, let air-dry. Use of gloves appropriate for dish washing recommended. Rinse hands and other skin areas exposed to material thoroughly after handling.


RESPONSE
