

FAST KLEEN

For Cleaning and Descaling Industrial and/or Commercial Recirculating Cooling Water Towers, Cool Cell Pads, Water Lines, and Hard Environmental Surfaces.

Ingredients: Water, Cationic Surfactants, Citric Acid.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use water containing residue from use of this product to irrigate crops for food or feed. Use of the product in either public/municipal or single or multiple family private/residential potable/drinking water systems is strictly prohibited. Use of the product in any cooling water system that discharge effluent within 1/4 mile of either a public or single or multiple family private/residential potable/ drinking water intake is strictly prohibited.

FAST KLEEN aids in cleaning and descaling evaporative condensers, heat exchange water systems, industrial and commercial cooling towers. When used as directed, **FAST KLEEN** is effective in cleaning drinking water lines.

CLEANING NIPPLE WATERERS

Cleaning waterers between cycles (no animals present): Dilute 1:1 with water and proportion into the water lines at one ounce per gallon (8m/L). Open the drain at the end of the line. When foam appears, close the drain. Allow treatment to stay in the line 12-18 hours. Then, disconnect the proportioner and let clear water run until no foam appears at the end of the line.

CLEANING COOL CELLS: With pump on, add into the sump tank 1/2 ounce of **FAST KLEEN** per gallon of water. Allow maximum circulation through the pads. Wash pads with garden hose. Drain all water from the systems including reservoirs, sump tanks, and filters. Refill the tank with clean water.

CLEANING COOL CELL PADS: 1. Turn off pump to cool cell pad. 2. Mix 1 gallon of **FAST KLEEN** with 25 gallons of water. Saturate the pad with solution. 3. Wash pads with water hose or water under pressure.

AS A GENERAL PURPOSE CLEANER for poultry, swine, veal, dairy, canine and equine operations and farm equipment. Clean with 1-2 ounces per gallon of **FAST KLEEN**. Follow with alkaline disinfectant to neutralize all residues of organic acid.

WETTING AGENT IN BARN WASH DOWN: Add 1 gallon to 300-500 gallons of water to facilitate initial poultry or animal premise wash down.

FARROWING HOUSE USE: Remove gross soils by shoveling, sweeping and flushing with clear water. Apply **FAST KLEEN** at 1-2 ounces per gallon by spray or foam. After a few minutes, clean with water under pressure. Scrub any areas that require additional cleaning. Disinfect.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS - PREVENTION

Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses), protective clothing, and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with water, remove contacts if present, flush with water again. Seek medical attention if irritation persists. **IF SWALLOWED:** Not harmful in normal quantities. Seek medical attention if more than one gallon is ingested **IF INHALED:** Move victim to fresh air. Seek medical attention if breathing is distressed. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Not Harmful. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish.
